Hangar exterior must be of white painted steel or aluminum, with white trim and doors. The exception is Dave Oleson's hangar, which will color blend with existing hangars facing Hwy 84. Floors must be of concrete, 4" minimum thickness, reinforced with ½" rebar, tied and 16" on center. No water or sewer connections or floor drains allowed. Eaves must extend 6" past walls. Gable ends may be flush or overhang up to 6". Please make a floor plan drawing on the reverse side, indicating where any doors and windows will be placed. Only horizontal or vertical bi-fold doors for aircraft entry are allowed. No garage type doors on other walls are available, except on hangars backing up to Hwy 84 between the airport garage and main airport entry road. New construction applications must be approved by MNDot and the City of Longville. Applications must be on the agenda by the Friday preceding the City Council Meeting (3rd Wednesday of each month). The permit fee is \$100.00 and is available at the City Clerk's office. 218-363-2022. Annual lease forms, information and rates are available from the City Clerk.
